12 WHEREAS, management and white-collar professionals manage
13 the day-to-day operations of many government facilities, act as
14 bridges between ideas and implementation and protect core
15 constitutional rights; and

16 WHEREAS, public employees are vital to the health of New
17 Mexico's economy and communities by purchasing goods and
18 services from local businesses and volunteering with local
19 charities, neighborhood associations, places of faith and
20 schools; and

21 WHEREAS, public employees should be recognized for their
22 dedication and commitment to their professions and for being
23 integral to making New Mexico a great place to live;
