WHEREAS, Representative Bill McCamley, a Democrat, will be
leaving office after serving three terms in the house of
representatives; and

WHEREAS, since 2013, Representative McCamley has
represented district 33, covering Dona Ana county; and

WHEREAS, Representative McCamley is the chair of the labor
and economic development committee and a member of the energy,
environment and natural resources committee and the rules and
order of business committee; and

WHEREAS, Representative McCamley is also the chair of the
interim New Mexico finance authority oversight committee; and

WHEREAS, prior to serving in the legislature,

6 land remediation; and

7 WHEREAS, Representative McCamley is a strong supporter of
8 clean energy; economic development, including along the border
9 with Mexico; legalizing cannabis for recreational use; and
10 fighting for a fair tax system; and

11 WHEREAS, Representative McCamley is known for his sharp,
12 impassioned speeches when advocating for the causes he
13 supports; and

14 WHEREAS, Representative McCamley was born on a military
15 base in Pusan, South Korea, where his father was stationed in
16 the United States army; and

17 WHEREAS, Representative McCamley is a graduate of Mayfield
18 high school in Las Cruces and received a bachelor of arts
19 degree in government from New Mexico state university in 2001
20 and a master of public policy degree from the John F. Kennedy
21 school of government at Harvard university in 2003; and

22 WHEREAS, Representative McCamley is a business outreach
23 director; and
