20	A. It is unlawful during the prohibited period for

1 treasurer, the commissioner of public lands or the state 2 auditor or a candidate for attorney general, state treasurer, commissioner of public lands or state auditor, to knowingly 3 solicit or accept a contribution [for a political purpose] 4 governed by the Campaign Reporting Act. For purposes of this 5 subsection, "prohibited period" means that period beginning 6 7 January 1 prior to any regular session of the legislature or, in the case of a special session, after the proclamation has 8 9 been issued, and ending on adjournment of the regular or special session. 10

B. It is unlawful during the prohibited period for the governor or the lieutenant governor, or any agent on [his] the governor's or the lieutenant governor's behalf, to knowingly solicit or accept a contribution [for a political purpose] governed by the Campaign Reporting Act. For purposes of this subsection, "prohibited period" means that period beginning January 1 prior to any regular session of the legislature or, in the case of a special session, after the proclamation has been issued, and ending on the twentieth day following the adjournment of the regular or special session."
