 - 4. On page 5, lines 16 and 17, strike "as authorized by law".
 - 5. On page 5, line 25, strike "or".
- 6. On page 6, line 9, strike the period and insert in lieu thereof "; or ".
- 7. On page 6, between lines 9 and 10, insert the following new paragraph:
 - "(8) the use of cage traps:
- (a) by an owner of a domestic animal to recover that animal;
- (b) to engage in a trap-neuter-return program for feral animals; or
- (c) by the department to trap beavers,
 muskrats and nutria; provided that the trap is not entirely
 submerged in water.".,
