HOUSE BILL 568

54TH LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - FIRST SESSION, 2019

AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; REAUTHORIZING OR
REAPPROPRIATING BALANCES, EXPANDING, CLARIFYING OR CHANGING
PURPOSES, EXTENDING EXPENDITURE PERIODS, CHANGING AGENCIES AND
ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS FOR THE REVERSION OR TRANSFER OF
UNEXPENDED BALANCES OF APPROPRIATIONS MADE BY THE LEGISLATURE
IN PRIOR YEARS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--REVERSION OF PROCEEDS.--

A. Except as otherwise provided in another section
of this act:

(1) the unexpended balance from the proceeds
of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been
reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax
bonding fund:

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underscored material = new
[bracketed material] = delete

1 (a) at the end of the expenditure period
2 as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is changed
3 in this act; or

4 (b) if the expenditure period is not
5 changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in
6 the law that originally authorized the severance tax bonds or
7 the time frame set forth in any law that has previously
8 reauthorized the expenditure of the proceeds, whichever is
9 later; and

10 (2) all remaining balances from the proceeds
11 of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been
12 reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax
13 bonding fund three months after the reversion date for the
14 unexpended balances.

15 B. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
16 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
17 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding
18 written obligations to third parties.

19 SECTION 2. GENERAL FUND AND OTHER FUND APPROPRIATIONS--
20 REVERSIONS.--

21 A. Except as otherwise provided in another section
22 of this act:

23 (1) the unexpended balance of an appropriation
24 from the general fund or other state fund that has been changed
25 in this act shall revert:

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1 (a) at the end of the expenditure period
2 as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is changed
3 in this act; or

4 (b) if the expenditure period is not
5 changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in
6 the law in which the original appropriation was made or the
7 time frame set forth in any law that has previously changed the
8 appropriation, whichever is later; and

9 (2) all remaining balances of an appropriation
10 from the general fund or other state fund that has been changed
11 in this act shall revert three months after the reversion date
12 for the unexpended balance.

13 B. Except as provided in Subsection C of this
14 section, the balance of an appropriation made from the general
15 fund or other state fund shall revert pursuant to Subsection A
16 of this section to the originating fund.

17 C. The balance of an appropriation made from the
18 general fund or other state fund to the Indian affairs
19 department or the aging and long-term services department for a
20 project located on lands of an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo
21 shall revert pursuant to Subsection A of this section to the
22 tribal infrastructure project fund.

23 D. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
24 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
25 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding

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1 written obligations to third parties.

2 **SECTION 3. ALBUQUERQUE SINGING ARROW COMMUNITY CENTER**
3 **IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of
4 expenditure for the local government division project in
5 Subsection 56 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st
6 S.S.) to acquire land and rights of way for and to plan,
7 design, construct, furnish and equip improvements to the
8 Singing Arrow community center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
9 county is extended through fiscal year 2021.

10 **SECTION 4. BERNALILLO COUNTY AMISTAD YOUTH CRISIS CENTER**
11 **IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of
12 expenditure for the local government division project in
13 Subsection 4 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.)
14 to plan, design, construct, furnish and equip improvements to
15 the Amistad youth crisis center in the South Valley area of
16 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2021.

17 **SECTION 5. BERNALILLO COUNTY CARLITO SPRINGS OPEN SPACE**
18 **IMPROVEMENTS PHASES 2 AND 3--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX**
19 **BONDS.--**The time of expenditure for the local government
20 division project in Subsection 5 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of
21 Laws 2015 (1st S.S.) to plan, design, construct, renovate,
22 equip and furnish phase 2 and phase 3 improvements to the
23 Carlito Springs open space area in the East Mountain area of
24 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2021.

25 **SECTION 6. SOUTH VALLEY COMMONS INFRASTRUCTURE**

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1 CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
 2 expenditure for the local government division project in
 3 Subsection 13 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st
 4 S.S.) to plan, design and construct infrastructure at the South
 5 Valley commons in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal
 6 year 2021.

7 **SECTION 7. TECHNOLOGY LEADERSHIP HIGH SCHOOL LAND**
 8 ACQUISITION--CHANGE TO SOUTH VALLEY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CENTER
 9 CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE AGENCY--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX
 10 BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the public education
 11 department project in Subsection 18 of Section 15 of Chapter 3
 12 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.) to acquire land for Technology
 13 Leadership high school in Bernalillo county shall not be
 14 expended for the original purpose but is appropriated to the
 15 local government division to plan, design, construct, furnish
 16 and equip improvements to the South Valley economic development
 17 center in Bernalillo county. The time of expenditure is
 18 extended through fiscal year 2021.

19 **SECTION 8. SECOND JUDICIAL DISTRICT ATTORNEY SECURITY**
 20 EQUIPMENT PURCHASE--EXPAND PURPOSE--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The
 21 second judicial district attorney project in Laws 2018, Chapter
 22 80, Section 11 to purchase and install security cameras,
 23 equipment and related technology for the office of the second
 24 judicial district attorney in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county
 25 may include planning, designing, constructing and renovating

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1 that office.

2 **SECTION 9. ALBUQUERQUE ASIAN AMERICAN MONUMENT**

3 CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
4 expenditure for the local government division project in
5 Subsection 20 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st
6 S.S.) to plan, design, landscape and construct an Asian
7 American monument in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is
8 extended through fiscal year 2021.

9 **SECTION 10. ALBUQUERQUE DOWNTOWN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT**

10 PROJECT CONSTRUCTION--EXPAND PURPOSE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE
11 TAX BONDS.--The local government division project in Subsection
12 28 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.) to plan,
13 design, construct, furnish and equip improvements for economic
14 development projects in downtown Albuquerque in Bernalillo
15 county may include planning, designing, constructing and
16 equipping development projects at the rail yards in downtown
17 Albuquerque. The time of expenditure is extended through
18 fiscal year 2021.

19 **SECTION 11. ALBUQUERQUE EXPLORA SCIENCE CENTER AND**

20 CHILDREN'S MUSEUM PHASE 2C CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE
21 TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the local government
22 division project in Subsection 31 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of
23 Laws 2015 (1st S.S.) to plan, design, construct, equip and
24 furnish phase 2c of the building addition and to design,
25 construct, purchase and install exhibits, furnishings and

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1 equipment at the Explora science center and children's museum
 2 in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal
 3 year 2021.

4 **SECTION 12. ALBUQUERQUE SOUTHEAST ALTERNATIVE RESPONSE**
 5 **STATION CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO CONSTRUCT AND EQUIP FIRE**
 6 **STATION 12--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The unexpended
 7 balance of the appropriation to the local government division
 8 in Subsection 54 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st
 9 S.S.) to plan, design, construct, furnish and equip an
 10 alternative response station in southeast Albuquerque in
 11 Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the original
 12 purpose but is changed to acquire rights of way and to plan,
 13 design, construct, furnish and equip fire station 12 in
 14 southeast Albuquerque. The time of expenditure is extended
 15 through fiscal year 2021.

16 **SECTION 13. ALBUQUERQUE HEIGHTS COMMUNITY CENTER**
 17 **IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of
 18 expenditure for the local government division project in
 19 Subsection 33 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st
 20 S.S.) to plan, design and construct improvements to the Heights
 21 community center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is
 22 extended through fiscal year 2021.

23 **SECTION 14. ALBUQUERQUE ROADRUNNER LITTLE LEAGUE**
 24 **INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX**
 25 **BONDS.--**The time of expenditure for the local government

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1 division project in Subsection 51 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of
2 Laws 2015 (1st S.S.) to plan, design, renovate and construct
3 infrastructure improvements, including turf replacement, to the
4 Roadrunner little league park and fields in Albuquerque in
5 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2021.

6 SECTION 15. ALBUQUERQUE WEST CENTRAL AVENUE ECONOMIC
7 DEVELOPMENT PHASE 2 INFRASTRUCTURE CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO
8 IMPROVE UNSER CROSSING INFRASTRUCTURE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE
9 TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the appropriation to the
10 local government division originally authorized in Subsection
11 45 of Section 31 of Chapter 226 of Laws 2013 and reauthorized
12 in Laws 2017, Chapter 133, Section 20 to plan, design and
13 construct phase 2 infrastructure improvements for an economic
14 development project along west Central avenue in Albuquerque in
15 Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the original or
16 reauthorized purpose but is changed to plan, design and
17 construct infrastructure improvements for an economic
18 development project at Unser crossing near the intersection of
19 Central avenue and Unser boulevard in Albuquerque. The time of
20 expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2021.

21 SECTION 16. ALBUQUERQUE WELLS PARK COMMUNITY CENTER
22 BASKETBALL FLOOR INSTALLATION--CHANGE TO RENOVATIONS--EXTEND
23 TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the
24 appropriation to the local government division in Subsection 63
25 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.) to plan,

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1 design, construct, purchase and install a wood floor for a
 2 basketball court at the Wells Park community center in
 3 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the
 4 original purpose but is changed to plan, design, construct,
 5 renovate and make improvements to that center. The time of
 6 expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2021.

7 **SECTION 17. ALBUQUERQUE WESTGATE COMMUNITY CENTER**
 8 **EQUIPMENT AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY PURCHASE--EXTEND TIME--**
 9 **SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of expenditure for the local
 10 government division project in Subsection 66 of Section 28 of
 11 Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.) to plan, design, construct
 12 and equip, including purchase and installation of information
 13 technology and related furniture and infrastructure, a
 14 community center for the Westgate community in Albuquerque in
 15 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2021.

16 **SECTION 18. AMY BIEHL HIGH SCHOOL ELEVATOR REPLACEMENT--**
 17 **CHANGE TO IMPROVE HEATING, VENTILATION AND AIR CONDITIONING**
 18 **SYSTEMS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The unexpended
 19 balance of the appropriation to the public education department
 20 in Subsection 3 of Section 14 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to
 21 plan, design, construct and replace an elevator at Amy Biehl
 22 high school in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be
 23 expended for the original purpose but is changed to repair,
 24 upgrade, purchase and install boilers and heating, ventilation
 25 and air conditioning systems at that school. The time of

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1 expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2021.

2 SECTION 19. BERNALILLO COUNTY NORTH VALLEY LITTLE LEAGUE
3 FIELDS LAND ACQUISITION AND CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--
4 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the local
5 government division project in Subsection 76 of Section 28 of
6 Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.) to acquire land for and to
7 plan, design, construct and equip ball fields for the North
8 Valley little league in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is
9 extended through fiscal year 2021.

10 SECTION 20. COTTONWOOD CLASSICAL PREPARATORY SCHOOL PHASE
11 1 SPORTS CENTER CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO IMPROVE BUILDINGS AND
12 GROUNDS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended
13 balance of the appropriation to the public education department
14 in Subsection 6 of Section 15 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st
15 S.S.) to plan, design and construct phase 1 of a multipurpose
16 sports complex at Cottonwood Classical preparatory school in
17 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the
18 original purpose but is changed to plan, design, construct,
19 renovate, furnish and equip buildings and grounds, including
20 the purchase of security systems, security fencing, information
21 technology and installation of related equipment and
22 infrastructure, at that school. The time of expenditure is
23 extended through fiscal year 2021.

24 SECTION 21. INTERSTATE 40 AND PASEO DEL VOLCAN
25 INTERCHANGE RIGHTS OF WAY ACQUISITION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE

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1 TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the department of
 2 transportation project in Subsection 8 of Section 33 of Chapter
 3 3 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.) to acquire rights of way for
 4 construction of the interstate 40 and Paseo del Volcan
 5 interchange in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended
 6 through fiscal year 2021.

7 SECTION 22. LA PROMESA EARLY LEARNING CENTER

8 IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
 9 expenditure for the public education department project in
 10 Subsection 11 of Section 15 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st
 11 S.S.) to plan, design, construct, renovate and equip facilities
 12 and to purchase and install information technology for La
 13 Promesa early learning center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
 14 county is extended through fiscal year 2021.

15 SECTION 23. NEW MEXICO STATE FAIR AFRICAN AMERICAN

16 PAVILION STAGE CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX
 17 BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the state fair commission
 18 project originally authorized in Subsection 1 of Section 17 of
 19 Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 and reauthorized in Laws 2017, Chapter
 20 133, Section 26 to plan, design and construct a stage for the
 21 African American pavilion at the New Mexico state fairgrounds
 22 in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal
 23 year 2021.

24 SECTION 24. NEW MEXICO STATE FAIR AFRICAN AMERICAN

25 PERFORMING ARTS CENTER EXHIBIT CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--

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1 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the state
2 fair commission project originally authorized in Subsection 2
3 of Section 17 of Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 and for which the time
4 of expenditure was extended in Laws 2017, Chapter 133, Section
5 27 to design, construct, purchase and install exhibits and to
6 acquire art, artifacts and equipment for the New Mexico state
7 fair African American performing arts center in Albuquerque in
8 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2021.

9 SECTION 25. SOUTHWESTERN INDIAN POLYTECHNIC INSTITUTE
10 FIRE ALARM IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The
11 time of expenditure for the higher education department project
12 in Subsection 2 of Section 34 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st
13 S.S.) for fire alarm improvements campuswide at southwestern
14 Indian polytechnic institute in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
15 county is extended through fiscal year 2021.

16 SECTION 26. SOUTH VALLEY YOUTH CRISIS CENTER
17 IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
18 expenditure for the local government division project in
19 Subsection 83 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st
20 S.S.) to plan, design, construct and furnish improvements to a
21 youth crisis center in the South Valley in Albuquerque in
22 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2021.

23 SECTION 27. HOBSON ROAD IMPROVEMENTS ROSWELL--EXTEND
24 TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the
25 department of transportation project in Subsection 13 of

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1 Section 33 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.) to plan,
 2 design, repair, replace and construct improvements to Hobson
 3 road in Roswell in Chaves county is extended through fiscal
 4 year 2021.

5 **SECTION 28. ROSWELL STATE POLICE DISTRICT OFFICE**

6 RENOVATION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
 7 expenditure for the capital program fund project in Laws 2015
 8 (1st S.S.), Chapter 3, Section 65 to plan, design, renovate,
 9 equip and furnish, including temporary relocation, the New
 10 Mexico state police district office in Roswell in Chaves county
 11 is extended through fiscal year 2020.

12 **SECTION 29. COLFAX COUNTY INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY**

13 INFRASTRUCTURE PURCHASE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The
 14 time of expenditure for the local government division project
 15 in Subsection 96 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st
 16 S.S.) to plan, design, construct, purchase and install
 17 information technology infrastructure, including related
 18 furniture and equipment, in Colfax county is extended through
 19 fiscal year 2021.

20 **SECTION 30. MINERS' COLFAX MEDICAL CENTER SOLARIUMS**

21 RENOVATION--CHANGE TO DESIGN AND CONSTRUCT PATIENT TREATMENT
 22 ROOMS, REGISTRATION AREA AND CLINIC ENTRANCE--EXTEND TIME--
 23 MINERS' TRUST FUND.--The unexpended balance of the
 24 appropriation to the miners' Colfax medical center in
 25 Subsection 5 of Section 72 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.)

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1 to plan, design, renovate, equip and furnish solariums at the
2 miners' Colfax medical center in Raton in Colfax county shall
3 not be expended for the original purpose but is changed to
4 plan, design, construct and equip patient treatment rooms, the
5 registration area and the entryway of the clinic at that
6 medical center. The time of expenditure is extended through
7 fiscal year 2021.

8 **SECTION 31. MINERS' COLFAX MEDICAL CENTER CARDIAC**
9 **MONITORING SYSTEM PURCHASE--CHANGE TO PURCHASE MEDICAL,**
10 **SURGICAL AND DIAGNOSTIC EQUIPMENT--EXTEND TIME--MINERS' TRUST**
11 **FUND.--**The unexpended balance of the appropriation to the
12 miners' Colfax medical center originally authorized in
13 Subsection 2 of Section 39 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to
14 purchase, install and equip a cardiac monitoring system at the
15 miners' Colfax medical center in Colfax county shall not be
16 expended for the original purpose but is changed to purchase
17 medical, surgical and diagnostic equipment at that medical
18 center in Raton in Colfax county. The time of expenditure is
19 extended through fiscal year 2021.

20 **SECTION 32. MINERS' COLFAX MEDICAL CENTER EMERGENCY**
21 **DEPARTMENT RENOVATION--CHANGE TO PURCHASE MOBILE OUTREACH VAN,**
22 **SECURITY EQUIPMENT AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY--EXTEND TIME--**
23 **MINERS' TRUST FUND.--**The unexpended balance of the
24 appropriation to the miners' Colfax medical center in
25 Subsection 1 of Section 72 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.)

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1 to renovate emergency department facilities at the miners'
 2 Colfax medical center in Raton in Colfax county shall not be
 3 expended for the original purpose but is changed to purchase
 4 and equip a mobile occupational health screening outreach van,
 5 to purchase and install a patient call and security access
 6 system and to purchase and install information technology at
 7 that medical center. The time of expenditure is extended
 8 through fiscal year 2021.

9 **SECTION 33. MINERS' COLFAX MEDICAL CENTER EMERGENCY POWER**
 10 **SYSTEM MODIFICATIONS--CHANGE TO PARKING LOT AND LIGHTING**
 11 **IMPROVEMENTS AND EQUIPMENT PURCHASES--EXTEND TIME--MINERS'**
 12 **TRUST FUND.--**The unexpended balance of the appropriation to the
 13 miners' Colfax medical center in Subsection 2 of Section 72 of
 14 Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.) to modify emergency power
 15 systems at the miners' Colfax medical center in Raton in Colfax
 16 county shall not be expended for the original purpose but is
 17 changed to purchase and install parking lot improvements, to
 18 purchase equipment and vehicles and to purchase light emitting
 19 diode lighting at that medical center. The time of expenditure
 20 is extended through fiscal year 2021.

21 **SECTION 34. CLOVIS COMMUNITY COLLEGE BARRACKS DEMOLITION**
 22 **AND ASBESTOS ABATEMENT--EXPAND PURPOSE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE**
 23 **TAX BONDS.--**The higher education department project in
 24 Subsection 3 of Section 34 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.)
 25 to demolish barracks and peripheral structures, including

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1 asbestos abatement, at Clovis community college in Curry county
2 may include paving at that facility. The time of expenditure
3 is extended through fiscal year 2021.

4 **SECTION 35. CLOVIS LYCEUM THEATER MULTI-USE FACILITY**
5 **DEVELOPMENT--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of
6 expenditure for the local government division project in
7 Subsection 100 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st
8 S.S.) to renovate and restore the historic Lyceum theater and
9 to acquire buildings and plan, design, renovate and equip
10 property adjacent to the theater for a performing arts and
11 multi-use facility in Clovis in Curry county is extended
12 through fiscal year 2021.

13 **SECTION 36. CLOVIS SENIOR CENTER CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND**
14 **TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of expenditure for the
15 aging and long-term services department project in Subsection
16 21 of Section 3 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.) to acquire
17 land for and to plan, design, construct, furnish and equip a
18 senior center in Clovis in Curry county is extended through
19 fiscal year 2021.

20 **SECTION 37. LAS CRUCES CINEMATIC INFRASTRUCTURE**
21 **CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO PLAN, DESIGN AND CONSTRUCT ANTHONY**

14 and trenching, lighting, electrical, plumbing and heating,
15 ventilation and air conditioning systems and purchase and
16 installation of garage doors, in Mountainair in Torrance
17 county. The time of expenditure is extended through fiscal
18 year 2021.

19 SECTION 114. BELEN HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL STADIUM PRESS BOX
20 CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO IMPROVE SECURITY--EXTEND TIME--
21 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the
22 appropriation to the public education department in Subsection
23 257 of Section 15 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.) to plan,
24 design and construct a press box at the football stadium at
25 Belen high school in the Belen consolidated school district in
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1 Valencia county shall not be expended for the original purpose
2 but is changed to plan, design, construct, purchase and install
3 security systems and improvements, including security cameras
4 and infrastructure, at the high school. The time of
5 expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2021.

6 SECTION 115. LOS LUNAS SPORTS COMPLEX FACILITY
7 IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
8 expenditure for the local government division project in
9 Subsection 242 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st
10 S.S.) for design, construction and improvements to a sports
11 complex in Los Lunas in Valencia county is extended through
12 fiscal year 2021.

13 SECTION 116. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public
14 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.

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
