| 18 | A. Agencies authorized by statute to conduct                    |

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the federal bureau of investigation. The department of public safety shall submit fingerprints to the federal bureau of investigation's system of ongoing review and continuous evaluation of the criminal history of individuals for the purpose of future searches of the system.

Authorized agencies participating in the federal Β. bureau of investigation program shall pay the actual cost of subscription fees to the department of public safety. Pursuant to Section 2 of this act, the department of public safety shall pay subscription fees charged by the federal bureau of investigation.

C. The department of public safety shall promulgate rules pursuant to this section.

For purposes of this section, "national criminal D. history record check" means a check of criminal history records entailing the fingerprinting of the individual and submission of the fingerprints to the federal bureau of investigation for the purpose of obtaining the national criminal history record of the person from the federal bureau of investigation.

SECTION 2. [<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION SUBSCRIPTION FUND--FUND CREATED.--The "federal bureau of investigation subscription fund" is created in the state treasury. The fund consists of money appropriated by the legislature to the fund and fees collected pursuant to Section l of this act. Money in the fund shall not revert to any other .213628.1
