17	SECTION 1. A new section of the Crime Victims Reparation

Child abuse homicide review team members shall Η. 21 not be subject to civil liability for any act related to the 22 review of a child-abuse-related homicide; provided that the 23 members act in good faith, without malice and in compliance 24 with other state or federal law. 25
