18	Section 2-3-13 NMSA 1978 to the contrary, the legislative
19	council service shall, within thirty days after the adjournment
20	of a legislative session in which the legislature passes a
21	capital outlay bill and after either the governor acts on the
22	bill or the deadline for that action passes, publish on the New
23	Mexico legislature's website a searchable listing of all the
24	projects in the bill that specifies:
25	A. those authorized for funding and those receiving
