19	threat.
20	B. Whoever commits making a school threat is guilty
21	of a fourth degree felony.
22	C. As used in this section, "school threat" means a
23	threat to commit any offense involving violence to a person on
24	school property, or to harm school property, that is
25	unequivocal unconditional and specific so as to convey a
