## AN ACT

FOR THE LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION STUDY COMMITTEE

RELATING TO SCHOOL SAFETY; ESTABLISHING NEW REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOOL EVACUATION, SHELTER-IN-PLACE AND ACTIVE SHOOTER DRILLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 22-13-14 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967, Chapter 16, Section 188, as amended) is amended to read:

"22-13-14. EMERGENCY DRILLS--REQUIREMENT.--

A. An emergency drill shall be conducted in each public and private school of the state at least [once each week during the first four weeks of the] four times during each school year [and at least once each month thereafter until the end of the school year]. At least two drills during the year shall be shelter-in-place drills that include preparation to respond to an active shooter and [one] two shall be [an evacuation drill, as directed by the department. The remainder

of the drills shall be fire] evacuation drills. It shall be the responsibility of the person in charge of a school to carry out the provisions of this section.

- In locations where a fire department is maintained, a member of the fire department shall be requested to be in attendance during the emergency drills for the purpose of giving instruction and constructive criticism.
- The department shall determine penalties for any C. person failing to meet the provisions of this section."
