14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 SECTION 1. Section 34-13-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993,
16 Chapter 273, Section 2) is amended to read:

17 "34-13-2. JUDICIAL EDUCATION CENTER CREATED--PURPOSE.--

18 A. The "judicial education center" is created at
19 the institute of public law at the university of New Mexico law
20 school.

21 B. The judicial education center shall provide
22 education, training and instruction for the justices, judges,
23 magistrates and court personnel of the state, municipalities
24 and counties, and for tribal judges, with an appropriate amount
25 of time to be devoted each year to training and instruction on
