11 RELATING TO EDUCATION; AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC EDUCATION
12 DEPARTMENT TO SELECT AN EXTERNAL DIPLOMA PROGRAM FOR ADULTS WHO
13 HAVE NOT GRADUATED FROM HIGH SCHOOL.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 SECTION 1. Section 22-2-8.8 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1999,
17 Chapter 193, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

18 "22-2-8.8. HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY CREDENTIAL--EXTERNAL
19 DIPLOMA.--

20 A. The department shall issue a high school
21 equivalency credential to any candidate who is at least sixteen
22 years of age and who has successfully completed the high school
23 equivalency credential tests.

24 B. The department shall authorize an external
25 diploma program for adults who have not graduated from high
