20	A. The university of New Mexico bureau of business
21	and economic research shall conduct an evaluation of all past,
22	present and reasonably foreseeable future fiscal impacts of the

The evaluation shall analyze the fiscal impact on the entities listed in Subsection A of this section with 8 9 regard to: system infrastructure, including parks, 10 (1) 11 recreational facilities, roads, sidewalks and streets; 12 (2) project infrastructure, including parks, 13 recreational facilities, roads, sidewalks and streets; 14 (3) utilities, including electricity, gas, sewage and water utilities; and 15 schools and other public facilities and 16 (4) associated infrastructure. 17 18 C. Upon completion of the evaluation, the 19 university of New Mexico bureau of business and economic 20 research shall present a report to the interim legislative committees tasked with studying economic development and water 21 issues. SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred thousand dollars 10 11 (\$100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board 12 of regents of the university of New Mexico for expenditure in fiscal year 2020 for the bureau of business and economic 13 14 research to evaluate the fiscal impact on state and local 15 governments of the proposed Santolina development in Bernalillo county.
