

SENATE EDUCATION COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR
SENATE BILL 667

54TH LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - FIRST SESSION, 2019

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PUBLIC PEACE, HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE;
MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS.--

A. The following amounts are appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of the university of New Mexico for expenditure in fiscal year 2020 for the following purposes:

(1) nine hundred forty-four thousand dollars (\$944,000) for American Indian student services for student recruitment and retention, summer bridge programs and academic, cultural and financial advisement; and

(2) five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the American Indian language policy, research and teacher

2 B. The following amounts are appropriated from the
3 general fund to the board of regents of New Mexico highlands
4 university for the following purposes:

5 (1) for the Ben Lujan leadership institute,
6 six hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$625,000) for
7 bachelor's and master's degrees, administrative licensure,
8 teacher recruitment and retention and parental institutes;

9 (2) for the center for the education and study
10 of diverse populations, seven hundred seventy-five thousand
11 dollars (\$775,000) for teacher training, staff development,
12 curriculum development, culturally responsive leadership,
13 English language learner development standards, bilingual
14 support, instructional leadership and youth leadership;

15 (3) for the school of social work, two hundred
16 fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the Native American
17 social workers institute; and

18 (4) for American Indian student services, two
19 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for student support,
20 academic and financial advisement, student retention and
21 internships.

22 C. Three hundred thirty-seven thousand dollars
23 (\$337,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board
24 of regents of New Mexico state university for the college of
25 education's American Indian program.
