SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 592 proposes to add the Manzano land grant-merced in Torrence county under Chapter 49, Article 1, NMSA 1978. To accomplish this, the bill also repeals the grant-merced's statute.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

No fiscal impact.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

According to the NMAG, the bill would have the primary effect of clarifying that the land grant is a political subdivision of the state. However, the bill would also lead to other changes including the need to establish a board of trustees and set compensation and terms of office for trustees.

NMAG noted while Section 49-7-1 currently defines the land grant as "a body corporate and politic," suggesting that it is also a political subdivision, this is not stated expressly. Moreover, not all bodies corporate and politic are necessarily political subdivisions. *See* § 58-10-33 (providing that "[e]very association incorporated pursuant to, or operating under, the provisions

of the Savings and Loan Act has all powers authorized by the corporation laws of this state, is a body corporate and politic"). However, that is the general meaning of a "body... politic." *See Gallagher v. Albuquerque Metro. Arroyo Flood Control Auth.*, 1977-NMCA-029, ¶ 8, 90 N.M. 309, 312 (noting that, "The role of a body politic, a political subdivision of the State, is the role of an instrumentality of state government."). As such, this is a complex issue and House Bill 592 would resolve it.

PERFORMANCE IMPLICATIONS

According to Chapter 49 definitions, a "land grant-merced" means a grant of land made by the government of Spain or by the government of Mexico to a community, town, colony or pueblo or to a person for the purpose of founding or establishing a community, town, colony or pueblo.

A political subdivision is a separate legal entity of a State which usually has specific governmental functions. The term ordinarily includes a county, city, town, village, or school district, and, in many states, a sanitation, utility, reclamation, drainage, flood control, or similar district.

ALTERNATIVES

NMAG suggested one alternative to modifying Section 49-1-2, as the bill currently proposes, is to instead add language in Section 49-7-1 providing that La Merced del Manzano is a political subdivision. That could read as:

That certain land grant situate in the county of Torrance in the state of New Mexico is hereby incorporated and formed into a body corporate and politic and a political subdivision of the State of New Mexico under the name and title of "La Merced del Manzano"; and as such corporate body and in its name shall have the right and power to sue and be sued.
