SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Joint Resolution 2 authorizes the State Game Commission to transfer an approximately 22-acre tract of land known as Laguna Del Campo (formerly known as Burns Lake) in Rio Arriba County to the Tierra Amarilla Land Grant-Merced.

SJR 2 provides ratification and approval by the Legislature under NMSA 1978, Section 13-6-3, which requires legislative approval prior to the disposition, including donation, of state real property with a value of \$100,000 or more. SJR 2 states that an appraisal of the Laguna Del Campo land tract obtained by DGF valued the tract at \$224,000.

After transfer, SJR 2 provides that the land tract is to become part of the common lands of the Tierra Amarilla land grant-merced. If it ceases to be part of those common lands, ownership of the tract shall revert to the State Game Commission.
