Synopsis of Memorial

Senate Memorial 100 requests the Department of Finance and Administration convene a task force consisting of representatives from New Mexico counties, the Legislative Finance Committee (LFC) and the New Mexico Municipal League to study the feasibility of increasing the per diem rate for public officers and employees. The task force would report its findings and recommendations to the LFC by November 1, 2019.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The study requested by SM100 would likely be conducted with existing staff at a central location to limit travel expenses. For this reason, it is unlikely the requirements of SM100 will increase costs to participating agencies and governmental entities.
