A MEMORIAL

DECLARING FEBRUARY 11, 2019 "UNM SCHOOL OF PUBLIC
ADMINISTRATION DAY" IN THE SENATE.

WHEREAS, on February 11, 1969, the university of New
Mexico faculty approved the proposal submitted by university of
New Mexico vice president Chester Travelstead for the
establishment of a division of public administration; and

WHEREAS, the university of New Mexico school of public
administration is the oldest public administration program in
New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, the university of New Mexico school of public
administration is one of the original seventeen programs
accredited over forty years ago by the network of schools of
public policy, affairs and administration; and

WHEREAS, the university of New Mexico school of public

1 administration has over two thousand graduates, seventy-five
2 percent of whom live, work and serve communities throughout New
3 Mexico; and

4 WHEREAS, the university of New Mexico school of public
5 administration's graduates have served in elected offices at
6 the highest levels of government in the state, including state
7 treasurer, secretary of state, state senators and
8 representatives; and

9 WHEREAS, the university of New Mexico school of public
10 administration includes graduates serving in appointed senior
11 leadership positions throughout the state, such as city and
12 county managers, department directors and other important
13 high-level posts; and

14 WHEREAS, in 2018, *U.S. News & World Report* ranked the
15 university of New Mexico school of public administration in the
16 top one hundred public affairs programs in the United States;

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE
18 OF NEW MEXICO that the leadership, accomplishments and
19 contributions of the university of New Mexico school of public
20 administration to the state be recognized; and

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that February 11, 2019 be declared
22 "UNM School of Public Administration Day" in the senate; and

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
24 transmitted to the director of the university of New Mexico
