10 A JOINT RESOLUTION

11 GRANTING CONCURRENT LEGISLATIVE JURISDICTION TO THE UNITED
12 STATES OVER CERTAIN UNITS OF THE NATIONAL PARK SYSTEM IN NEW
13 MEXICO.

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 19-2-2
17 NMSA 1978, concurrent legislative jurisdiction is granted to
18 the United States over lands and waters owned, managed, leased
19 or administered by the United States within the authorized
20 boundaries of the following units of the national park system
21 in New Mexico:

22 A. Petroglyph national monument; and

23 B. Valles Caldera national preserve.

24 Specific legal descriptions of the park boundaries are to be
25 provided by the national park service.
