AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE INDIAN AFFAIRS DEPARTMENT FOR SECURITY SERVICES FOR AN INTERNATIONAL NATIVE AMERICAN CULTURAL EVENT IN SANTA FE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
