11 RELATING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT; REQUIRING THE GOVERNOR TO DETAIL A
12 SELECT GROUP OF STATE POLICE OFFICERS TO BE STATIONED IN
13 CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 SECTION 1. Section 29-2-21 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1941,
17 Chapter 147, Section 20, as amended) is amended to read:

18 "29-2-21. DETAILS.--

19 A. The governor [~~of New Mexico~~] may from time to
20 time detail all or any part of the [~~New Mexico~~] state police to
21 such part of the state as in [~~his~~] the governor's judgment may
22 be necessary to bring about proper law enforcement in the state
23 to handle disturbances or to investigate specific law
24 violations.

25 B. The governor shall convene a strike force of

2 with a population of five hundred thousand persons or more
3 according to the most recent federal decennial census from July
4 1, 2020 until June 30, 2021."

5 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the
6 provisions of this act is July 1, 2020.
