AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE HIGHER EDUCATION DEPARTMENT FOR NEW MEXICO'S INDEPENDENT COLLEGES TO PLAN AND IMPLEMENT A STATEWIDE STUDENT INFORMATION AND ENTERPRISE RESOURCE PLANNING SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. Three million two hundred thousand dollars (\$3,200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the higher education department for expenditure in fiscal year 2021 for New Mexico's independent colleges to plan and implement a statewide student information and enterprise resource planning system, including student information services and financial and human resources systems. Funding shall be provided in the following amounts:

1	(1) seven hundred fifty thousand dollars
2	(\$750,000) to Clovis community college;
3	(2) four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000)
4	to Luna community college;
5	(3) seven hundred fifty thousand dollars
6	(\$750,000) to Santa Fe community college;
7	(4) three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000)
8	to San Juan college; and
9	(5) one million dollars ($\$1,000,000$) to
10	central New Mexico community college.
11	B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
12	at the end of fiscal year 2021 shall revert to the general
