SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 76 amends the statutory provision creating the Eastern New Mexico Water Utility Authority (NMSA 1978, Section 73-27-4) to remove Curry County, the Village of Melrose, and the Village of Grady from membership in the Eastern New Mexico Water Utility Authority. HB 76 also reduces the number of members on the Authority's board from seven to six.

There is no effective date of this bill. It is assumed that the effective date is 90 days following adjournment of the Legislature.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There is no appropriation contained in this bill and no significant fiscal impact is identified at this time.

CONFLICT, DUPLICATION, COMPANIONSHIP, RELATIONSHIP

This bill duplicates SB 50.
