Synopsis of HTPWC Amendment

The House Transportation, Public Works and Capital Improvements Committee amendment to House Bill 327 changes the destination of the \$25 million appropriation from DOT to the local government division of the Department of Finance and Administration.

Synopsis of Original Bill

House Bill 327 appropriates \$25 million from the general fund to the Department of Transportation (DOT) for the construction of the southeast loop road located in Eddy County.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$25 million contained in this bill is a nonrecurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 22 shall revert to the general fund.
