Synopsis of Bill

House Memorial 49 requests the United States Congress to designate a portion of U.S. Highways 64 and 87 as federal interstate.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

HM49 would not result in any direct costs to the state. However, DOT notes that an interstate designation would require a highway meet all the standards of an interstate highway, before designation. U.S. 64 and 87 are not designed to meet 75 mile per hour speeds nor do they meet criteria for lane width, shoulder width, maximum grade, or other requirements. Improving these highways to meet interstate standards would require a significant funding increase.
