### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 45 appropriates \$300 thousand from the general fund to DFA to provide operational support for a homeless shelter and supportive housing program in the city of Santa Fe.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$300 thousand contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance at the end of FY21 reverts to the general fund.

### SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Homeless shelters and supportive housing programs help homeless persons by providing emergency food, shelter and counseling, as well as referrals to partnering human service agencies.

### WHAT WILL BE THE CONSEQUENCES OF NOT ENACTING THIS BILL

The homeless shelter the bill support's will need to seek other sources of funding for operations.
