## A JOINT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE 4, SECTION 5 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF NEW MEXICO TO CHANGE THE LENGTH OF LEGISLATIVE REGULAR SESSIONS FROM SIXTY DAYS IN ODD-NUMBERED YEARS AND THIRTY DAYS IN EVEN-NUMBERED YEARS TO FORTY-FIVE DAYS IN EACH YEAR, WITHOUT LIMITATION ON SUBJECTS FOR CONSIDERATION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. It is proposed to amend Article 4, Section 5 of the constitution of New Mexico to read:

"[A.] Each regular session of the legislature shall begin annually at 12:00 noon on the third Tuesday of January. Every regular session of the legislature [convening during an odd-numbered year] shall remain in session not to exceed [sixty days, and every regular session of the legislature convening during an even-numbered year shall remain in session not to
