  - 5. On page 2, line 3, after "three", insert "voting".
- 6. On page 2, line 25, after "utility", strike the remainder of the line.
  - 7. On page 3, strike lines 1 and 2 in their entirety.
- 8. On page 3, line 3, strike "retired" and insert in lieu thereof "that qualifies pursuant to the provisions of Subsection B of Section 71-10-3 NMSA 1978".
  - 9. On page 3, line 10, after "additional", insert "voting".
- 10. On page 5, between lines 11 and 12, insert the following new section:
- "SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.".
