agency or their representatives, except that if the number of elected officials reasonably available and willing to serve is less than one-third of the membership of the board, membership on the board of appointive officials may be counted in meeting this one-third requirement;

- at least one-third of the members shall be (2) persons chosen in accordance with democratic selection procedures adequate to [assure] ensure that they are representative of the poor in the area served; and
- the other members shall be officials or (3) members of business, industry, labor, religious, welfare, education or other major groups and interests in the community.
- Each member of the board selected to represent a specific geographic area within a community shall reside in the area represented.
- No person selected under Paragraph (2) or (3) of Subsection A of this section shall serve for more than five consecutive years [or more than a total of ten years]."
