

HOUSE TAXATION AND REVENUE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL 296

55TH LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - FIRST SESSION, 2021

AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; REAUTHORIZING OR
REAPPROPRIATING BALANCES, EXPANDING OR CHANGING PURPOSES,
EXTENDING EXPENDITURE PERIODS, CLARIFYING PROJECT LOCATIONS,
CHANGING AGENCIES AND ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS FOR THE REVERSION
OR TRANSFER OF UNEXPENDED BALANCES OF APPROPRIATIONS MADE BY
THE LEGISLATURE IN PRIOR YEARS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--REVERSION OF PROCEEDS.--

A. Except as otherwise provided in another section
of this act:

(1) the unexpended balance from the proceeds
of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been
reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax
bonding fund:

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1 (a) at the end of the expenditure period
2 as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is changed
3 in this act; or

4 (b) if the expenditure period is not
5 changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in
6 the law that originally authorized the severance tax bonds or
7 the time frame set forth in any law that has previously
8 reauthorized the expenditure of the proceeds, whichever is
9 later; and

10 (2) all remaining balances from the proceeds
11 of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been
12 reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax
13 bonding fund three months after the reversion date for the
14 unexpended balances.

15 B. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
16 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
17 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding
18 written obligations to third parties.

19 SECTION 2. GENERAL FUND AND OTHER FUND APPROPRIATIONS--
20 REVERSIONS.--

21 A. Except as otherwise provided in another section
22 of this act:

23 (1) the unexpended balance of an appropriation
24 from the general fund or other state fund that has been changed
25 in this act shall revert:

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1 (a) at the end of the expenditure period
2 as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is changed
3 in this act; or

4 (b) if the expenditure period is not
5 changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in
6 the law in which the original appropriation was made or the
7 time frame set forth in any law that has previously changed the
8 appropriation, whichever is later; and

9 (2) all remaining balances of an appropriation
10 from the general fund or other state fund that has been changed
11 in this act shall revert three months after the reversion date
12 for the unexpended balance.

13 B. Except as provided in Subsection C of this
14 section, the balance of an appropriation made from the general
15 fund or other state fund shall revert pursuant to Subsection A
16 of this section to the originating fund.

17 C. The balance of an appropriation made from the
18 general fund or other state fund to the Indian affairs
19 department or the aging and long-term services department for a
20 project located on lands of an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo
21 shall revert pursuant to Subsection A of this section to the
22 tribal infrastructure project fund.

23 D. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
24 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
25 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding

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1 written obligations to third parties.

2 **SECTION 3.** PASEO DEL VOLCAN UNSER BOULEVARD BYPASS RIGHTS
3 OF WAY ACQUISITION AND CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX
4 BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the department of
5 transportation project originally authorized in Subsection 54
6 of Section 36 of Chapter 226 of Laws 2013 and reauthorized in
7 Laws 2015, Chapter 147, Section 62 and for which the time of
8 expenditure was extended in Laws 2017, Chapter 133, Section 69
9 and again in Laws 2019, Chapter 280, Section 66 to acquire
10 rights of way and to plan, design and construct a paseo del
11 Volcan loop bypass to run from Unser boulevard to interstate
12 highway 40 in Bernalillo and Sandoval counties is extended
13 through fiscal year 2023.

14 **SECTION 4.** PASEO DEL VOLCAN RIGHTS OF WAY ACQUISITION
15 FROM UNSER BOULEVARD TO THE BERNALILLO COUNTY LINE IN SANDOVAL
16 COUNTY--CHANGE TO ACQUIRE RIGHTS OF WAY AND TO CONSTRUCT PASEO
17 DEL VOLCAN--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended
18 balance of the appropriation to the department of
19 transportation originally authorized in Subsection 57 of
20 Section 33 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.) and
21 reauthorized in Laws 2019, Chapter 280, Section 83 to purchase
22 rights of way for paseo del Volcan from Unser boulevard to the
23 Bernalillo-Sandoval county line shall not be expended for the
24 original purpose but is changed to acquire rights of way and to
25 plan, design and construct paseo del Volcan in Bernalillo and

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1 Sandoval counties. The time of expenditure is extended through
2 fiscal year 2023.

3 **SECTION 5. ATRISCO HERITAGE HIGH SCHOOL ACCESS ROAD**
4 **CONSTRUCTION--EXPAND PURPOSE--CHANGE AGENCY--GENERAL FUND.--**The
5 department of transportation project in Subsection 25 of
6 Section 40 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design and
7 construct an access road to Atrisco heritage high school,
8 including modifications to Senator Dennis Chavez boulevard,
9 118th street and 98th street, in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
10 county is appropriated to the local government division for
11 that purpose and may include planning, design, repair and
12 construction of driveways, trail connections, sidewalks and
13 signal modifications to Senator Dennis Chavez boulevard and to
14 118th street, for the Atrisco heritage academy high school in
15 Bernalillo county.

16 **SECTION 6. BERNALILLO COUNTY AMISTAD YOUTH CRISIS CENTER**
17 **IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of
18 expenditure for the local government division project
19 originally authorized in Subsection 4 of Section 28 of Chapter
20 3 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.) and reauthorized in Laws 2019,
21 Chapter 280, Section 4 to plan, design, construct, furnish and
22 equip improvements to the Amistad youth crisis center in the
23 South Valley area of Bernalillo county is extended through
24 fiscal year 2023.

25 **SECTION 7. BERNALILLO COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AGENCY**
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1 EQUIPMENT PURCHASE--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of
2 expenditure for the local government division project in
3 Subsection 4 of Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to
4 purchase and install furniture and equipment, including a
5 forklift, a shredder and sanitation equipment, for facilities
6 and programs at a community development and assistance agency
7 in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2023.

8 SECTION 8. BERNALILLO COUNTY DITCH ACCESS CONTROL GATE
9 IMPROVEMENTS--CHANGE TO SOUTH VALLEY DITCH ACCESS GATE
10 IMPROVEMENTS--CHANGE AGENCY--GENERAL FUND.--The unexpended
11 balance of the appropriation to the interstate stream
12 commission in Subsection 1 of Section 34 of Chapter 81 of Laws
13 2020 to purchase, replace and install access control gates for
14 ditches and acequias in Bernalillo county shall not be expended
15 for the original purpose but is appropriated to the local
16 government division to purchase, deliver and install materials
17 and equipment and to plan, design, construct, improve and equip
18 existing and new access control gates for ditches and acequias
19 in the South Valley area of Bernalillo county.

20 SECTION 9. SOUTH VALLEY DITCH ACCESS CONTROL GATES
21 CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO CONSTRUCT AND IMPROVE ACCESS CONTROL
22 GATE--GENERAL FUND.--The unexpended balance of the
23 appropriation to the local government division in Subsection 20
24 of Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design,
25 purchase, construct and install access control gates for

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1 ditches and acequias in the South Valley area of Bernalillo
2 county shall not be expended for the original purpose but is
3 changed to purchase, deliver and install materials and
4 equipment and to plan, design, construct, improve and equip
5 existing and new access control gates for ditches and acequias
6 in the South Valley.

7 SECTION 10. MIDDLE RIO GRANDE CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

8 ALAMEDA DRAIN TRAIL SECURITY SYSTEMS--CHANGE AGENCY--SEVERANCE
9 TAX BONDS.--The agency for the office of the state engineer
10 project originally authorized in Subsection 1 of Section 25 of
11 Chapter 82 of Laws 2020 for fencing and security systems along
12 the Alameda drain trail for the middle Rio Grande conservancy
13 district in Bernalillo county is changed to the local
14 government division.

15 SECTION 11. TWENTY-FIRST CENTURY PUBLIC ACADEMY CHARTER

16 SCHOOL EQUIPMENT PURCHASE--CHANGE TO HEATING, VENTILATION AND
17 AIR CONDITIONING SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS--GENERAL FUND.--The
18 unexpended balance of the appropriation to the public education
19 department in Subsection 27 of Section 63 of Chapter 81 of Laws
20 2020 to acquire security systems, fencing and related equipment
21 for the Twenty-First Century public academy charter school in
22 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the
23 original purpose but is changed to plan, design, construct,
24 renovate, furnish and equip buildings and grounds and to
25 purchase and install heating, ventilation and air conditioning

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1 and air filtration systems and related equipment and to
2 purchase and install information technology, including related
3 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, and for wiring and
4 fencing for the Twenty-First Century public academy charter
5 school.

6 SECTION 12. ALBUQUERQUE FAMILY SERVICES VEHICLES

7 PURCHASE--EXPAND PURPOSE--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The local
8 government division project in Subsection 54 of Section 34 of
9 Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to purchase and equip a vehicle and to
10 upgrade facilities and purchase equipment for a specialized
11 family services program in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county may
12 include the purchase and installation of information
13 technology, including related equipment, furniture and
14 infrastructure. The time of expenditure is extended through
15 fiscal year 2023.

16 SECTION 13. CENTRAL NEW MEXICO COMMUNITY COLLEGE BLOCK

17 CHAIN CENTER CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO BLOCK CHAIN CENTER
18 DEVELOPMENT, CONSTRUCTION AND EQUIPMENT--SEVERANCE TAX
19 BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the appropriation to the
20 higher education department in Subsection 2 of Section 39 of
21 Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to plan, design and construct a block
22 chain center at central New Mexico community college in
23 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the
24 original purpose but is changed to conduct feasibility studies,
25 to design, develop, acquire, build, improve, furnish and equip

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1 information technology and to install a distributed ledger
2 technology system at central New Mexico community college.

3 SECTION 14. NEW MEXICO STATE FAIR AFRICAN AMERICAN
4 PERFORMING ARTS CENTER EXHIBIT IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--
5 GENERAL FUND.--The time of expenditure for the state fair
6 commission project in Subsection 2 of Section 27 of Chapter 277
7 of Laws 2019 to plan, design, purchase and install exhibits and
8 artifacts and to equip and furnish the African American
9 performing arts center at the New Mexico state fairgrounds in
10 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal
11 year 2023.

12 SECTION 15. INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 40 AND PASEO DEL VOLCAN
13 INTERCHANGE RIGHTS OF WAY ACQUISITION--CHANGE TO ACQUIRE RIGHTS
14 OF WAY AND CONSTRUCT PASEO DEL VOLCAN--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE
15 TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the appropriation to the
16 department of transportation originally authorized in
17 Subsection 8 of Section 33 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.)
18 and reauthorized in Laws 2019, Chapter 280, Section 21 to
19 acquire rights of way for construction of the interstate
20 highway 40 and paseo del Volcan interchange in Albuquerque in
21 Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the original
22 purpose but is changed to acquire rights of way for and to
23 plan, design and construct paseo del Volcan. The time of
24 expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2023.

25 SECTION 16. SOUTHWEST AERONAUTICS, MATHEMATICS AND

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1 SCIENCE ACADEMY CHARTER SCHOOL IMPROVEMENTS--CHANGE TO BUILDING
2 AND GROUNDS RENOVATION--GENERAL FUND.--The unexpended balance
3 of the appropriation to the public education department in
4 Subsection 18 of Section 20 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to
5 plan, design, construct, renovate, furnish and equip the
6 buildings and grounds, including bathroom improvements to
7 comply with the federal Americans with Disabilities Act of
8 1990, fencing, information technology, wiring and
9 infrastructure, at SAMS academy charter school in Albuquerque
10 in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the original
11 purpose but is changed to plan, design, construct, renovate,
12 furnish and equip buildings and grounds and to purchase and
13 install related equipment, information technology, wiring and
14 security infrastructure for the SAMS academy charter school.

15 SECTION 17. SOUTHWESTERN INDIAN POLYTECHNIC INSTITUTE
16 FIRE ALARM IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The
17 time of expenditure for the higher education department project
18 originally authorized in Subsection 2 of Section 34 of Chapter
19 3 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.) and reauthorized in Laws 2019,
20 Chapter 280, Section 25 for fire alarm improvements campuswide
21 at southwestern Indian polytechnic institute in Albuquerque in
22 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2023.

23 SECTION 18. ALBUQUERQUE SPORTS AND CULTURAL CENTER PHASE
24 1 CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO JOAN JONES COMMUNITY CENTER PHASE 2
25 CONSTRUCTION--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Twenty-four percent of the
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1 unexpended balance of the appropriation to the local government
 2 division in Subsection 116 of Section 35 of Chapter 81 of Laws
 3 2020 to acquire land for and to plan, design and construct
 4 phase 1 of a sports and cultural center, including art
 5 exhibits, public outdoor spaces, retail and dining facilities
 6 and playing fields, in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall
 7 not be expended for the original purpose but is changed to
 8 plan, design and construct phase 2 of the Joan Jones community
 9 center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county.

10 **SECTION 19. ALBUQUERQUE ATRISCO AREA BICYCLE RECYCLING**
 11 **CENTER EQUIPMENT PURCHASE--CHANGE TO EQUIP THE SCHOOL ON**
 12 **WHEELS--CHANGE AGENCY--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--**The
 13 unexpended balance of the appropriation to the local government
 14 division in Subsection 32 of Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws
 15 2019 to purchase tools and equipment for a community bicycle
 16 recycling program in the Atrisco community and southwest area
 17 of Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for
 18 the original purpose but is appropriated to the public
 19 education department to plan, design, construct, purchase,
 20 equip and furnish outdoor benches and shade structures for the
 21 School on Wheels in the Albuquerque public school district in
 22 Bernalillo county. The time of expenditure is extended through
 23 fiscal year 2023.

24 **SECTION 20. LOS RANCHOS DE ALBUQUERQUE VETERAN**
 25 **AGRICULTURAL EQUIPMENT PURCHASE--CHANGE TO AGRICULTURAL**

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1 EQUIPMENT AND VEHICLE PURCHASE--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The
2 unexpended balance of the appropriation to the local government
3 division in Subsection 59 of Section 26 of Chapter 80 of Laws
4 2018 to purchase and install equipment and a greenhouse for a
5 veteran agricultural and job training program in Los Ranchos de
6 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the
7 original purpose but is changed to purchase and equip vehicles
8 and to purchase and install equipment for the Agri-Nature
9 center in Los Ranchos de Albuquerque.

10 SECTION 21. HOBSON ROAD ROSWELL DETENTION POND

11 IMPROVEMENTS--CHANGE TO HOBSON ROAD PAVING IMPROVEMENTS--
12 GENERAL FUND.--The unexpended balance of the appropriation to
13 the department of transportation in Subsection 44 of Section 40
14 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design, replace, construct
15 and install culverts for the Hobson road detention pond and to
16 plan, design and construct improvements, including paving, for
17 Hobson road from Hummingbird lane to Baker road in Roswell in
18 Chaves county shall not be expended for the original purpose
19 but is changed to plan, design and construct culverts for the
20 detention pond and to plan, design and construct paving
21 improvements, including asphalt, micro-surfacing, slurries,
22 overlays, concrete turnouts, soil stabilization and
23 intersection repairs, on Hobson road from United States highway
24 285 to Menominee road in Chaves county.

25 SECTION 22. ACOMA PUEBLO WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY

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1 IMPROVEMENTS--CHANGE AGENCY--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX
2 BONDS.--The agency for the department of environment project
3 originally authorized in Subsection 6 of Section 18 of Chapter
4 81 of Laws 2016 to plan, design and construct expansions and
5 upgrades to the North Acomita wastewater treatment facility at
6 the Pueblo of Acoma in Cibola county and reauthorized in Laws
7 2020, Chapter 82, Section 31 is changed to the Indian affairs
8 department. The time of expenditure is extended through fiscal
9 year 2023.

10 SECTION 23. ANTHONY WATER AND SANITATION DISTRICT DESERT
11 AIRE WASTEWATER SYSTEM DESIGN--CHANGE TO VEHICLE PURCHASE--
12 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the
13 appropriation to the department of environment in Subsection 8
14 of Section 20 of Chapter 80 of Laws 2018 to plan, design and
15 construct a sewer collection and lift station and a force main
16 system in the Desert Aire area for the Anthony water and
17 sanitation district in Dona Ana county shall not be expended
18 for the original purpose but is changed to purchase and equip
19 vehicles for the Anthony water and sanitation district.

20 SECTION 24. DONA ANA COUNTY SPRING CANYON ARROYO DAM LAND
21 ACQUISITION AND CONSTRUCTION--CLARIFYING INTENT--SEVERANCE TAX
22 BONDS.--The office of the state engineer project in Subsection
23 5 of Section 25 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 is to plan, design,
24 acquire property for, construct and equip a flood control dam
25 on the lower Spring canyon arroyo in Dona Ana county.

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1 SECTION 25. SUNLAND PARK HYDROPONIC SYSTEM CONSTRUCTION--
2 CHANGE TO LA UNION WATERSHED DISTRICT FACILITIES IMPROVEMENTS--
3 GENERAL FUND.--The unexpended balance of the appropriation to
4 the local government division in Subsection 214 of Section 34
5 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design, construct,
6 purchase, equip and install hydroponic systems based on
7 geothermal heat in Sunland Park and the surrounding areas in
8 Dona Ana county shall not be expended for the original purpose
9 but is changed to acquire property and buildings and to plan,
10 design, renovate, improve, furnish and equip an administrative
11 and central operations building for La Union watershed district
12 in Dona Ana county.

13 SECTION 26. DELORES WRIGHT PARK IMPROVEMENTS--CHANGE TO
14 CHAPARRAL LIBRARY CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX
15 BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the appropriation to the
16 office of the state engineer originally authorized in
17 Subsection 4 of Section 18 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.)
18 and reauthorized to the local government division in Laws 2019,
19 Chapter 280, Section 39 to plan, design and construct
20 improvements to Delores Wright park in Chaparral in Dona Ana
21 county shall not be expended for the original or reauthorized
22 purpose but is changed to plan, design and construct a library
23 in Chaparral in Dona Ana county. The time of expenditure is
24 extended through fiscal year 2023.

25 SECTION 27. CHAPARRAL LIBRARY AND HEALTH COMPLEX STUDY--

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1 CHANGE TO LIBRARY CONSTRUCTION--GENERAL FUND.--The unexpended
2 balance of the appropriation to the local government division
3 in Subsection 298 of Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to
4 conduct a feasibility study to site, plan and develop a
5 schedule for construction of a library and health and wealth
6 multiplex in Chaparral in Dona Ana or Otero county shall not be
7 expended for the original purpose but is changed to plan,
8 design and construct a library in Chaparral in Dona Ana county.

9 SECTION 28. DELORES WRIGHT PARK SPORTS COMPLEX

10 FEASIBILITY STUDY--CHANGE TO BICYCLE MOTOCROSS TRACK
11 CONSTRUCTION--GENERAL FUND.--The unexpended balance of the
12 appropriation to the local government division in Subsection
13 185 of Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to conduct a
14 feasibility study and to develop an implementation schedule to
15 plan, design and construct a sports complex, including the
16 replacement of existing fields and the addition of basketball
17 courts, a dirt bike track and a splash pad, at Delores Wright
18 park in Chaparral in Dona Ana county shall not be expended for
19 the original purpose but is changed to plan, design and
20 construct a dirt bicycle motocross track at Delores Wright
21 park.

22 SECTION 29. DONA ANA COUNTY SAVANNAH PARK IMPROVEMENTS--
23 CHANGE TO LA MESA COMMUNITY CENTER IMPROVEMENTS--SEVERANCE TAX
24 BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the appropriation to the
25 local government division in Subsection 193 of Section 35 of

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1 Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 for improvements to Savannah park in
2 Dona Ana county shall not be expended for the original purpose
3 but is changed to plan, design, construct, purchase, install
4 and equip improvements, including a recreation room addition
5 and signage, to La Mesa community center in Dona Ana county.

6 SECTION 30. LAS CRUCES CINEMATIC INFRASTRUCTURE

7 CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
8 expenditure for the local government division project
9 originally authorized in Subsection 114 of Section 28 of
10 Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.) and reauthorized in Laws
11 2019, Chapter 280, Section 42 to plan, design, construct,
12 furnish and equip a facility and related infrastructure to be
13 owned by Las Cruces in Dona Ana county for film, digital media
14 and entertainment arts production is extended through fiscal
15 year 2023.

16 SECTION 31. INTERSTATE HIGHWAYS 10 AND 25 INTERSECTION

17 IMPROVEMENTS--CHANGE TO LAS CRUCES STREET MEDIAN IMPROVEMENTS--
18 EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The department of
19 transportation project in Subsection 29 of Section 32 of
20 Chapter 80 of Laws 2018 to plan, design, construct, purchase
21 and install landscaping and drainage improvements at the
22 interchange of interstate 10 and interstate 25 in Las Cruces in
23 Dona Ana county is changed to plan, design, construct, purchase
24 and install park improvements, landscaping and drainage
25 improvements to street medians in Las Cruces in Dona Ana

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1 county. The time of expenditure is extended through fiscal
2 year 2023.

3 SECTION 32. LAS CRUCES VILLA MORA DAM AREA IMPROVEMENTS--
4 CHANGE AGENCY--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The agency for the office
5 of the state engineer project originally authorized in
6 Subsection 6 of Section 25 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2020 to plan,
7 design, construct, equip, purchase and install improvements to
8 the Villa Mora dam area, including trails, parking and
9 lighting, in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county is changed to the
10 local government division.

11 SECTION 33. NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY KRWG TV EQUIPMENT
