## AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EDUCATION; CREATING THE NATIVE AMERICAN WEB-BASED RESOURCE TOOL FOR NATIVE AMERICAN STUDENTS HAFC→; MAKING

AN APPROPRIATION←HAFC.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

**SECTION 1.** A new section of the Public School Code is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] NATIVE AMERICAN WEB-BASED RESOURCE TOOL

FOR NATIVE AMERICAN STUDENTS -- CREATION -- CONTENTS -- TRIBAL OWNERSHIP. --

- The department shall develop, in collaboration with the Indian nations, tribes and pueblos of the state, a Native American web-based tool that provides resources for Native American students.
- The Native American web-based resource tool may contain the following:
- information on educational programs (1) focused on the needs of Native American students;
- (2) modules, interventions and educational approaches conducive to the educational needs of Native American students; and
- (3) information on local and regional Native American educational experts.
- C. All intellectual property provided by an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo shall belong to that Indian nation, tribe or pueblo and shall be provided to the department through HEC→a joint powers←HEC HEC→an intergovernmental←HEC agreement with each individual Indian nation, tribe or pueblo.
- The department shall enter into HEC→a joint powers agreement in accordance with Section 11-1-3 NMSA 1978←HEC HEC→an intergovernmental agreement←HEC with an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo to receive any intellectual property provided pursuant to Subsection C of this section.
  - The department shall host the Native American Ε.

HAFC SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. -- Two hundred fifty
thousand dollars (\$250,000) is appropriated from the general
fund to the public education department for expenditure in
fiscal year 2023 to develop and host the Native American webbased resource tool and to hire a full-time employee to oversee
the web-based resource tool. Any unexpended or unencumbered
balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2023 shall revert
to the general fund. CHAFC
