- 3. On page 21, between lines 3 and 4, insert the following new section:
- "SECTION 8. TEMPORARY PROVISION--TEMPORARY CONTINUED OPERATION OF ABANDONED FACILITY.--
- A. Notwithstanding abandonment approval of a qualifying generating facility granted by the public regulation commission on or after April 1, 2020, a qualifying utility may continue to operate such qualifying generating facility until July 1, 2024.
  - B. As used in this section:
- (1) "qualifying generating facility" means a coalfired generating facility in New Mexico that may be composed of multiple generating units that:
- (a) has been granted a certificate of public convenience and for which abandonment authority is granted after December 31, 2018;
- (b) is owned or leased, in whole or in part, by a qualifying utility; and
