AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO ENHANCE CERTAIN SUMMER AND OUT-OF-SCHOOL PROGRAMMING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--

A. Two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the public education department for expenditure in fiscal year 2023 to enhance six-week summer schools and out-of-school time programming by including literacy and mathematics enrichment, social-emotional learning, physical wellness and swimming, life and career skills and individualized tutoring for students from under-resourced families in kindergarten through twelfth grade who attend public schools in the Albuquerque metropolitan area.

Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of .222198.1
