- 1. Strike Item 1 of Senate Floor Amendment number 1.
- 2. On page 3, line 3, after "not", strike the remainder of the line and strike lines 4 and 5 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof a colon and the following:
- "(1) create a threat to the probationer or parolee;
 - (2) create a threat to others;
- (3) violate a condition that the probationer or parolee refrain from having contact with a victim or witness; or
 - (4) constitute a new crime."".
- 3. On page 3, line 24, strike "arrest" and insert in lieu thereof "an arrest warrant".
- 4. On page 4, line 18, remove the brackets and the line through "and regulations".
- 5. On page 6, lines 21 and 22, strike "director authorizes arrest" and insert in lieu thereof "court issues an arrest warrant".,
