10 AN ACT

11 RELATING TO PENSIONS; INCREASING THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF PENSION  
12 THAT A STATE POLICE MEMBER, CORRECTIONAL OFFICER MEMBER AND  
13 PROBATION AND PAROLE OFFICER MEMBER IS PERMITTED TO EARN  
14 PURSUANT TO THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT ACT.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

17 SECTION 1. Section 10-11-29 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1987,  
18 Chapter 253, Section 29, as amended) is amended to read:

19 "10-11-29. STATE POLICE MEMBER, CORRECTIONAL OFFICER  
20 MEMBER AND PROBATION AND PAROLE OFFICER MEMBER COVERAGE PLAN  
21 1--AMOUNT OF PENSION--FORM OF PAYMENT A.--Under state police  
22 member, correctional officer member and probation and parole  
23 officer member coverage plan 1, the amount of pension under  
24 form of payment A is equal to three percent of final average  
25 salary multiplied by credited service. The amount shall not

3 SECTION 2. APPLICABILITY.--The provisions of this act  
4 apply to credited service performed after the effective date of  
5 this act. Any credited service performed or amount of pension  
6 earned prior to the effective date of this act shall not be  
7 calculated or adjusted to conform to the provisions of this  
8 act.
