AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC RECORDS; PROVIDING AN EXCEPTION FOR
PROTECTED UTILITY CUSTOMER DATA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 14-2-1.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2019,
Chapter 27, Section 2) is amended to read:

"14-2-1.1. PERSONAL IDENTIFIER INFORMATION--PROTECTED
UTILITY CUSTOMER DATA.--

A. Protected personal identifier information
contained in public records may be redacted by a public body
before inspection or copying of a record. The presence of
protected personal identifier information on a record does not
exempt the record from inspection. Unredacted records that
contain protected personal identifier information shall not be
made available on publicly accessible websites operated by or

1 managed on behalf of a public body.

2 B. Protected utility customer data contained in
3 public records may be redacted by a public body before
4 inspection or copying of the record. The presence of protected
5 utility customer data in a record does not exempt the record
6 from inspection. Unredacted records that contain protected
7 utility customer data shall not be made available on publicly
8 accessible websites operated by or managed on behalf of a
9 public body."

10 SECTION 2. Section 14-2-6 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993,
11 Chapter 258, Section 3, as amended) is amended to read:

12 "14-2-6. DEFINITIONS.--As used in the Inspection of
13 Public Records Act:

14 A. "custodian" means any person responsible for the
15 maintenance, care or keeping of a public body's public records,
16 regardless of whether the records are in that person's actual
17 physical custody and control;

18 B. "file format" means the internal structure of an
19 electronic file that defines the way it is stored and used;

20 C. "inspect" means to review all public records
21 that are not excluded in Section 14-2-1 NMSA 1978;

22 D. "person" means any individual, corporation,
23 partnership, firm, association or entity;

24 E. "protected personal identifier information"
25 means:

2 (a) taxpayer identification number;
3 (b) financial account number; or
4 (c) driver's license number;
5 (2) all but the year of a person's date of
6 birth; and
7 (3) a social security number;

8 F. "protected utility customer data" means data
9 collected by automated utility metering that shows a person's
10 utility usage data in intervals shorter than the monthly
11 billing cycle;

12 [~~F.~~] G. "public body" means the executive,
13 legislative and judicial branches of state and local
14 governments and all advisory boards, commissions, committees,
15 agencies or entities created by the constitution or any branch
16 of government that receives any public funding, including
17 political subdivisions, special taxing districts, school
18 districts and institutions of higher education;

19 [~~G.~~] H. "public records" means all documents,
20 papers, letters, books, maps, tapes, photographs, recordings
21 and other materials, regardless of physical form or
22 characteristics, that are used, created, received, maintained
23 or held by or on behalf of any public body and relate to public
24 business, whether or not the records are required by law to be
25 created or maintained; and
