SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.--One hundred ninety-five
thousand dollars (\$195,000) is appropriated from the general
fund to the public education department for expenditure in
fiscal year 2024 to cover expenses for coaches to attend the
cardiopulmonary resuscitation certification program. Any
unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
fiscal year 2024 shall revert to the general fund.
