

1 A MEMORIAL

2 DECLARING FEBRUARY 13, 2023 "NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY
3 AGGIES FOOTBALL TEAM DAY" IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

5 WHEREAS, the New Mexico state university aggies football
6 team finished the 2022 regular season with a record of six
7 wins and six losses; and

8 WHEREAS, the aggies were invited to play in the Quick
9 Lane bowl at Ford field in Detroit, Michigan, on December 26,
10 2022, their fifth bowl game in school history; and

11 WHEREAS, the aggies ended a historic season in Michigan
12 with a twenty-four to nineteen victory over Bowling Green
13 state university in the Quick Lane bowl game; and

14 WHEREAS, the nationally televised game drew more than
15 two million three hundred thousand viewers from across the
16 country; and

17 WHEREAS, the aggies were led by quarterback and
18 Albuquerque native Diego Pavia, who accumulated one hundred
19 sixty-seven passing yards and an additional sixty-five
20 rushing yards and was named the most valuable player of the
21 Quick Lane bowl; and

22 WHEREAS, Trevor Brohard, a linebacker from Los Lunas,
23 recorded three tackles and an interception in his final game
24 for the crimson and white; and

25 WHEREAS, Shiyazh Pete, an offensive lineman from

1 Shiprock high school, led the way for the aggie offensive
2 line, allowing for four hundred seven yards of total offense
3 in the bowl game; and

4 WHEREAS, New Mexico state university head football coach
5 Jerry Kill led the aggies to seven wins in his first season
6 as the aggies head coach, just the third season with seven or
7 more wins for the aggies since 1968;

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
9 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New
10 Mexico state university aggies football team be congratulated
11 for its victory over Bowling Green state university at the
12 2022 Quick Lane bowl; and

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that February 13, 2023 be
14 proclaimed "New Mexico State University Aggies Football Team
15 Day" in the house of representatives; and

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be
17 transmitted to the head coach of the New Mexico state
18 university aggies football team. _____
