

1 A MEMORIAL

2 DECLARING FEBRUARY 13, 2023 "NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY
3 AGGIES FOOTBALL TEAM DAY" IN THE SENATE.

5 WHEREAS, the New Mexico state university aggies football
6 team finished the 2022 regular season with a record of six
7 wins and six losses; and

8 WHEREAS, the aggies were invited to play in the Quick
9 Lane bowl at Ford field in Detroit, Michigan, on
10 December 26, 2022, their fifth bowl game in school history;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, the aggies ended a historic season in Michigan
13 with a twenty-four to nineteen victory over Bowling Green
14 state university in the Quick Lane bowl game; and

15 WHEREAS, the nationally televised game drew more than
16 two million three hundred thousand viewers from across the
17 country; and

18 WHEREAS, the aggies were led by quarterback and
19 Albuquerque native Diego Pavia, who accumulated one hundred
20 sixty-seven passing yards and an additional sixty-five
21 rushing yards and was named the most valuable player of the
22 Quick Lane bowl; and

23 WHEREAS, Trevor Brohard, a linebacker from Los Lunas,
24 recorded three tackles and an interception in his final game
25 for the crimson and white; and

1 WHEREAS, Shiyazh Pete, an offensive lineman from
2 Shiprock high school, led the way for the aggie offensive
3 line, allowing for four hundred seven yards of total offense
4 in the bowl game; and

5 WHEREAS, New Mexico state university head football coach
6 Jerry Kill led the aggies to seven wins in his first season
7 as the aggies head coach, just the third season with seven or
8 more wins for the aggies since 1968;

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE
10 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico state university
11 aggies football team be congratulated for its victory over
12 Bowling Green state university at the 2022 Quick Lane bowl;
13 and

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that February 13, 2023 be
15 proclaimed "New Mexico State University Aggies Football Team
16 Day" in the senate; and

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be
18 transmitted to the head coach of the New Mexico state
19 university aggies football team. _____
