A MEMORIAL

DECLARING MARCH 1, 2023 "COLONIAS DAY" IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

WHEREAS, residents of rural and colonias communities face harsh challenges on a daily basis, but they are proud people who are reluctant to ask for help; and

WHEREAS, individual counties continue to undertake independent and ambitious infrastructure improvement plans designed to enhance social and economic development opportunities for all residents of New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, by initiating a statewide improvement program for rural and colonias communities, the state could partner with the thirty-three counties to empower these small communities and dramatically improve the quality of life in these communities while simultaneously creating new entrepreneurial
