11 RECOMMENDING THAT NEW MEXICO CONSIDER ADOPTION OF THE "CHILE
12 VERDE ROCK" SONG AS THE OFFICIAL NEW MEXICO CHILE SONG.

14 WHEREAS, the legislature has recognized, in addition to
15 "O, Fair New Mexico", certain songs that musically capture the
16 beauty, culture and character of this state; and

17 WHEREAS, the legislature has adopted a Spanish-language
18 state song, a state bilingual song, a state ballad and a state
19 cowboy song; and

20 WHEREAS, New Mexico does not have an official song about
21 chile, a recognized official vegetable of New Mexico; and

22 WHEREAS, as one of the most delicious vegetables known to
23 humankind, chile deserves recognition; and

24 WHEREAS, Uvaldo Olonia, a native of Taos, New Mexico, has
25 composed a musical tribute to chile that is worthy of bringing

1 to this humble vegetable the accolades it deserves; and

2 WHEREAS, a tribute in the form of a rock and roll song is
3 a fitting way to recognize this spicy vegetable; and

10 Mexico chile song; and

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
12 transmitted to the governor, the secretary of state, the
13 secretary of tourism and the secretary of cultural affairs and
14 to other appropriate state agencies.
