17	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	SECTION 1. It is proposed to amend Article 4, Section 5
19	of the constitution of New Mexico to read:

21	begin annually at 12:00 noon on the third Tuesday of January.
22	Every regular session of the legislature [convening during an
23	odd-numbered year shall remain in session not to exceed sixty
24	days, and every regular session of the legislature convening
25	during an even-numbered year] shall remain in session not to
