56TH LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - SECOND SESSION, 2024

AN ACT

RELATING TO FOOD; AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF A STATE MEAT
INSPECTION PROGRAM TO ENSURE THE SAFETY AND QUALITY OF MEAT FOR
HUMAN CONSUMPTION; PROVIDING PENALTIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of Chapter 25 NMSA 1978 is
enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] STATE MEAT INSPECTION PROGRAM--RULES--
PENALTIES--COOPERATION WITH FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.--

A. The New Mexico livestock board shall adopt rules
necessary to establish a comprehensive state meat inspection
program for the inspection, processing and sale of meat and
poultry products that meets or exceeds the standards and
requirements for a state meat inspection program under the
Federal Meat Inspection Act, the federal Poultry Products

1 Inspection Act and the federal Humane Methods of Slaughter Act
2 of 1978, including rules to:

3 (1) license facilities engaged in the
4 processing or manufacturing of meat and poultry products;

5 (2) establish license requirements and
6 reasonable fees; and

7 (3) provide inspection services.

8 B. The New Mexico livestock board shall only
9 administer and enforce the program established pursuant to
10 Subsection A of this section if the board receives approval
11 from the federal government for a state meat inspection
12 program.

13 C. A person violating a rule adopted by the New
14 Mexico livestock board pursuant to this section is guilty of a
15 misdemeanor and upon conviction may be sentenced to
16 imprisonment in the county jail for a term not to exceed one
17 year and payment of a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars
18 (\$1,000), unless that person acted in good faith.

19 D. The New Mexico livestock board shall actively
20 seek and maintain coordination with federal authorities to
21 ensure alignment with and approval of the state meat inspection
22 program."

23 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the
24 provisions of this act is July 1, 2024.
