17	SECTION 1. A new section of Chapter 31, Article 3 NMSA
18	1978 is enacted to read:
19	"[ <u>NEW MATERIAL</u> ] NO-BOND HOLD FOR VIOLATION OF CONDITIONS
20	OF RELEASE
21	A. When the chief clerk of a court receives notice
22	that a person on pretrial release for a felony is subsequently
23	arrested for a subsequent felony, the chief clerk of the court
24	shall issue an order for the person to remain in custody
25	without bond.
