services department shall maintain an accident insurance policy that covers search and rescue volunteers. The benefits of the policy shall, at a minimum, include:

(1) one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for the accidental death or dismemberment of a search and rescue volunteer that occurs during an authorized search and rescue mission or training exercise; and

(2) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for medical expenses related to injuries that search and rescue volunteers incur during authorized search and rescue missions or training exercises.

B. For the purposes of this section, "search and rescue volunteer" means an uncompensated person who is registered with the state search and rescue control agency as having volunteered on a search and rescue mission."

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
