BILL SUMMARY

<u>Synopsis</u>: This bill requires that private entities conduct age verification on their websites to ensure that minors do not access material the statute defines as harmful.

The bill further creates a private right of action, allowing any person to seek damages in District Court for violation of the act.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

This bill does not authorize enforcement by governmental entities, and so would not have any impact on an agency budget.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

This bill may conflict with the First Amendment.
