#### **BILL SUMMARY**

### Synopsis:

- Title: HOUSE BILL 59 Earned Wage Access Services Act
- Purpose: Regulates the provision of earned wage access services in New Mexico.

## • Key Provisions:

- Licensing: Requires providers to obtain a license from the Financial Institutions Division.
- Exemptions: Banks, savings and loan associations, and credit unions are exempt from licensing.

#### Consumer Protections:

- Providers must offer at least one no-cost option for consumers to access their wages.
- Clear disclosure of fees and terms to consumers.
- Prohibits providers from sharing fees or tips with employers.
- Limits on fees and prohibits certain charges like late fees or interest.
- o **Reporting**: Providers must file annual reports with detailed financial and operational data.
- o **Complaints**: Establishes a process for consumers to file complaints against providers.
- o Penalties: Violations of the act can result in fines ranging from \$500 to \$1,000.
- State Jurisdiction: The state has exclusive authority over the regulation of earned wage access services.
- o **Annual License**: Licenses must be renewed annually, with specific requirements for renewal.
- o **Investigations**: The division can investigate providers and examine their records to ensure compliance.
- o **Consumer Rights**: Providers must inform consumers of their rights and allow them to cancel services without fees.
- o **Privacy**: Providers must comply with all applicable privacy and information security laws.

Effective Date: This applies to licenses issued on or after October 15, 2025.
