BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

HB87 would eliminate the requirement that non-consensual touching be to an unclothed intimate part. The amendment broadens the scope of criminal liability from contact with unclothed intimate parts to any non-consensual contact with intimate parts, irrespective of whether clothing is present.
