Section 1 amends Section 31-22-8 entitled “Crimes Enumerated” of the Crime Victims Reparations Act.

Subsection (A)(2) is amended to include “assault” and “battery” as enumerated crimes.

Subsection (A)(10) is amended to include “criminal sexual contact” as an enumerated crime.

Subsection (A)(19) is new material added to include “robbery while armed with a deadly weapon” as an enumerated crime.
