Synopsis:

The Crime Victims Reparation Act (NMSA 1978, §§ 31-22-1 through -23 (as amended through 2019)) permits the victims of certain crimes to seek reparations. HB231 would amend the Act to make victims of certain additional crimes— assault, battery, criminal sexual contact, and robbery with a deadly weapon—eligible to receive reparation for injuries or death that may result from those crimes.
